History:

Founded in October of 2006 by Daniel and Mandy Watson in order to journey with low-income single mother families while bridging the gap between existing services.

Current Participating Families:

5 families with a total of 11 children

(55% African American, 45% Caucasian)

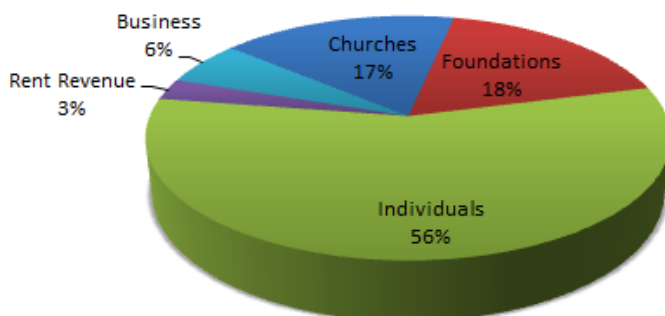
Average annual income upon entering the program: \$6,500

Participating Family Program Requirements:

- Meets weekly with Family Advocate to set long and short term goals
- Gives 2 hours of volunteer service to the community on a monthly basis
- Pays 30% of their income toward rent and utilities
- Develops relationships with a team of 6 to 8 mentors
- Meets regularly with a financial consultant along with attending financial literacy classes
- Goes to school and/or work full-time within six months of beginning the program
